A few updates that I wanted you to be aware of:

Clubhouse:

I wanted let you all know that the Club has successfully replaced our Septic/Sewer line. A special "thank you" to Tom Stewart, Ronnie Smith, Sylvester Garcia and Steve Huffman for their assistance with this project.

I did want to brief all of you on our Service Charge policy at the Club when you come out and enjoy food and beverage. I have had two members inquire as to how exactly the service charge works. The service charge is NOT a gratuity to our servers...It is a revenue line item that assists the Club to off-set the higher hourly wage that we pay our servers. A portion is used to off-set the wages and the remainder is revenue for the Club. As a member, you are welcome to give an additional gratuity to your server in the form of cash or it may be charged to your bill for that meal service. The entire amount of your gratuity goes directly to your server and if charged, it is put on their bi-monthly paycheck, less taxes of course. If anyone would like to discuss this further or needs further clarification, please call me directly at the Club.

Thank you to all members who pay their monthly statements on time! The Board of Directors is starting a NEW POLICY regarding payment of your monthly statement. Currently, your monthly statement is due on the 15th of the current month in which you receive your bill. The Club allows a grace period until the last day of the month. It is crucial that the Club receives your payment on time. Beginning October 1st, late payments will be assessed \$50 every 2 weeks.

Golf Tip of the month:

IMPROVING YOUR BUNKER PLAY

One of the most intimidating shots in golf is from a greenside bunker. This shot, however, is not nearly as difficult as most people think. It is one of the few shots in golf that perfectly solid contact is not necessary for at least moderate success. To be a good bunker player you must understand a few simple pre-shot adjustments and take some time to practice them.

SET UP ADJUSTMENTS

Open the Clubface- This increases the loft and more importantly the amount of bounce, increasing the effectiveness of the club in sliding through the sand. The softer the sand the more you will want to lay the clubface open. When swinging strive to keep the clubface pointed skyward before, during, and after the shot.

Dig your feet in- This has two effects. First it gives your feet more stability and secondly it lowers the arc of the swing so that it will now bottom out UNDER the ball rather than bottoming out AT the ball.

Body Alignment- Set your body 10-20 degrees to the left of your target to account for the opening of the clubface.

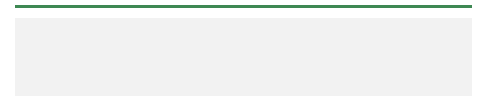
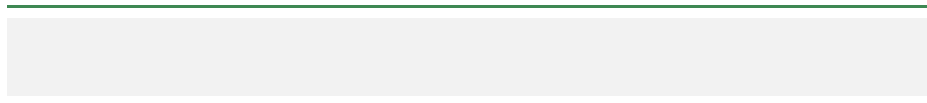
Ball Position- Position the ball forward in your stance where you would normally play your driver. This will help ensure the club entering the sand before the ball.

Practice these set up changes and you will see a drastic improvement in your bunker play.
